REGISTRATION FEE

The \$825 registration fee secures your group's spot at JTF. Your registration is considered complete once you have filled out the online registration form and we have received your registration fee. Your registration submission will be reviewed and you will be emailed if your group has been accepted to the festival within 3 weeks. If your group is not accepted, you can opt to add your group to the waitlist or your registration fee will be refunded.

PARTICIPATION FEE

Each person who attends JTF must be registered with their group, including directors, students, chaperones, and parents. Each festival attendee is required to pay the per-person participation fee. **A minimum of 20 participants per group is required** (including directors, students, chaperones, and parents). Participation fees for JTF Atlanta are due by October 15, 2025 and participation fees for JTF West are due by November 15, 2025. After these dates, participation fees increase by \$30 per-person . You will not be able to register individuals at Festival Sign-In the weekend of the festival. <u>Day passes are not available.</u>

How to Register Your Group

To register your group for JTF, visit **juniortheaterfestival.com**. If you are a returning group, log in with your existing credentials. If you are a new group, you will be prompted to create an account for your organization. Once that is complete and you are on the Registration page, select "Register As Group" and follow the prompts. You will be asked for estimated numbers of students, chaperones, directors, and any additional family and friends attending. This is a true estimate, and these numbers do not need to be finalized until the fall.

You will be asked to pay the \$825 registration fee in order to secure your group's spot at JTF. We will accept payment by credit card or check. Registration priority will be given to those that pay by credit card. If paying by check, **make checks payable to JUNIOR THEATER GROUP** and mail to iTheatrics, Attn: JTF, 1501 Broadway, Suite 1900, New York, NY 10036.

Once your group has been officially accepted, registration fees are nonrefundable.

Frequently Asked Questions

CAN I REGISTER FOR BOTH FESTIVALS?

You may register one group for JTF Atlanta and one group for JTF West. Groups that attend both festivals must bring different shows for adjudication, and we encourage you to bring different groups of students to each festival as well.

CAN I BRING TWO GROUPS FROM MY ORGANIZATION TO ONE FESTIVAL?

No. You may only bring one group from your organization to JTF Atlanta and one group from your organization to JTF West.

CAN I REGISTER FOLKS AFTER THE PARTICIPATION FEES ARE DUE?

This is done on a case-by-case basis and all additions must be approved by the JTF Festival administrator. Final numbers and payment are due by October 15th for JTF Atlanta and November 15th for JTF West in order to move forward with scheduling. If registered past those dates, there is no guarantee that additional participants will receive a festival t-shirt or have seats with your group in the main theater.

IS THERE AN AGE REQUIREMENT FOR PARTICIPATING STUDENTS?

Any student between the ages of 8 and 18 is welcome to attend and perform with a group. No one who has graduated from high school is allowed to perform with a group.

WHAT SIZE IS A TYPICAL GROUP

The average group size is 20 - 40 participants. There is a minimum of 20 participants per group. This number includes students, chaperones, directors, and any additional family and friends. The playing space for adjudication is roughly 20' x 26' so this is important to keep in mind when putting your group of students together.

Hotel Information

Official festival hotels for JTF Atlanta are the Waverly Renaissance, the Embassy Suites, and the Omni Hotel. Official festival hotels for JTF West are the Hyatt Regency Sacramento, and the Sheraton Grand Sacramento Hotel. Specific pricing and other pertinent information will be sent out once your group has been accepted to the festival. Rooms in these hotels must be booked directly through the Junior Theater Festival. Priority for official festival hotels will be given to groups based on the order registration is completed (online form submitted and registration fee received). You are not required to stay in an official festival hotel.

Please note, there is a limited amount of space in these hotels, and they fill up fast. There are many other great hotel options in the general vicinity of both festivals.
